



**GOD'S WORDS FOR TODAY (Lk. 24:35-48)**

**The Holy Gospel according to St. Luke**

The disciples of Jesus recounted what had taken place along the way, and how they had come to recognize him in the breaking of bread.

While they were still speaking about this, he stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." But they were startled and terrified and thought that they were seeing a ghost. Then he said to them, "Why are you troubled? And why do questions arise in your hearts? Look at my hands and my feet, that it is I myself. Touch me and see, because a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you can see I have." And as he said this, he showed them his hands and his feet. While they were still incredulous for joy and were amazed, he asked them, "Have you anything here to eat?" They gave him a piece of baked fish; he took it and ate it in front of them.

He said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the law of Moses and in the prophets and psalms must be fulfilled." Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures. And he said to them, "Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things."

**Reflection:**

When the disciples saw the risen Lord they disbelieved for joy! How can death lead to life, the cross to victory? Jesus shows us the way and he gives us the power to overcome sin and despair, and everything else that would stand in the way of his love and truth. Just as the first disciples were commissioned to bring the good news of salvation to all the nations, so, we, too, are called to be witnesses of the resurrection of Jesus Christ to all who live on the face of the earth. Do you witness the joy of the Gospel to those around you?

**Prayer:**

Lord Jesus, Anoint us with your power and give us joy and boldness to proclaim the Gospel in word and deed. Amen.

**FROM THE OVCAD – INSTITUTIONAL HEALTH SERVICES:**

***Preventing a brain aneurysm***

You can't always prevent brain aneurysms, but you can lower your risk by not smoking and reducing high blood pressure.

**Smoking**

If you smoke, stopping can significantly reduce your risk of developing a brain aneurysm.

**High blood pressure**

Having high blood pressure can also significantly increase your chance of developing a brain aneurysm.

You can help reduce high blood pressure by:

- eating a healthy diet – in particular, cutting down on salt and eating plenty of fruit and vegetables
- moderating your alcohol intake – men and women are advised not to regularly drink more than 14 units a week
- maintaining a healthy weight – even losing just a few pounds will make a big difference to your blood pressure and overall health
- exercising regularly – being active and taking regular exercise lowers blood pressure by keeping your heart and blood vessels in good condition
- cutting down on caffeine – it's fine to drink tea, coffee and other caffeine-rich drinks as part of a balanced diet, but it's important these drinks aren't your only source of fluid
