



GOD’S WORDS FOR TODAY (Jn 7:1-2, 10, 25-30)

The Holy Gospel according to St. John,

After this, Jesus went around in Galilee, purposely staying away from Judea because the Jews there were waiting to take his life. But when the Jewish Feast of Tabernacles was near. However, after his brothers had left for the Feast, he went also, not publicly, but in secret. At that point some of the people of Jerusalem began to ask, "Isn't this the man they are trying to kill? Here he is, speaking publicly, and they are not saying a word to him. Have the authorities really concluded that he is the Christ? But we know where this man is from; when the Christ comes, no one will know where he is from." Then Jesus, still teaching in the temple courts, cried out, "Yes, you know me, and you know where I am from. I am not here on my own, but he who sent me is true. You do not know him, but I know him because I am from him and he sent me." At this they tried to seize him, but no one laid a hand on him, because his time had not yet come.

Reflections:

Knowing Jesus and knowing about Jesus are two different things. Yes we know about Jesus’ life, death, and resurrection, but how far do we know him? As Christians, we ought to know not only the things and information about Jesus’ life, but more so about his true personality and characteristics as our Lord and Savior, we have to know Him personally. Jesus the Christ is our loving brother... our caring friend... our comforter... He is the merciful God who forgives our wrongdoings... and the answer to our needs...

Jesus has many attributions and this Lenten season; Christ is inviting us to know him more... to know him better, because it is in knowing Him that we can establish our love for God and for our neighbor. Let us thirst for his presence and hunger for his love...

Cont...Tuberculosis

1. **Wear a mask.** If you are forced to be around people, it's a good idea to wear a surgical mask that covers your mouth and nose, at least during the first three weeks following infection. This helps to lessen the risk of you passing the virus to someone else.
2. **Finish your course of medication.** It is absolutely essential that you finish whatever course of medication your doctor prescribes. Failing to do so gives the TB bacteria a chance to mutate, making the virus much more resistant

to medications, and therefore more deadly. Finishing your course of medications is the safest option not only for you, but for those around you.
