



**GOD’S WORDS FOR TODAY (Jn 5:31-47)**

**The Holy Gospel according to St. John,**

Jesus said to the Jews:

"If I testify about myself, my testimony is not valid. There is another who testifies in my favor, and I know that his testimony about me is valid. "You have sent to John and he has testified to the truth. Not that I accept human testimony; but I mention it that you may be saved. John was a lamp that burned and gave light, and you chose for a time to enjoy his light."

"I have testimony weightier than that of John. For the very work that the Father has given me to finish, and which I am doing, testifies that the Father has sent me. And the Father who sent me has himself testified concerning me. You have never heard his voice nor seen his form, nor does his word dwell in you, for you do not believe the one he sent. You diligently study the Scriptures because you think that by them you possess eternal life. These are the Scriptures that testify about me, yet you refuse to come to me to have life."

"I do not accept praise from men, but I know you. I know that you do not have the love of God in your hearts. I have come in my Father's name, and you do not accept me; but if someone else comes in his own name, you will accept him. How can you believe if you accept praise from one another, yet make no effort to obtain the praise that comes from the only God?"

**Reflection:**

We believe a person only if he or she is trustworthy. Someone who has betrayed our trust in the past will probably find us skeptical of anything that person might say.

We believe that the words of Jesus are true because He has proven Himself to be altogether reliable. We have no reason to doubt His promises, because He never leaves disappointed anyone who believes in Him.

***Cont...Tuberculosis***

How to Avoid Spreading TB

1. **Stay at home.** If you have active TB, you will need to take precautionary steps to avoid passing the disease onto others. You will need to stay at home from work or school for several weeks following diagnoses and avoid sleeping or spending long periods of time in a room with other people.
2. **Ventilate the room.** The TB virus spreads more easily in enclosed spaces with stagnant air. Therefore, you should open any windows or doors to let fresh air in and contaminated air out.
3. **Cover your mouth.** Just like when you have a cold, you will need to cover your mouth whenever you cough, sneeze or even laugh. You can use your hand if necessary, but using a tissue is preferable *to be cont...*
