REFLECTION:

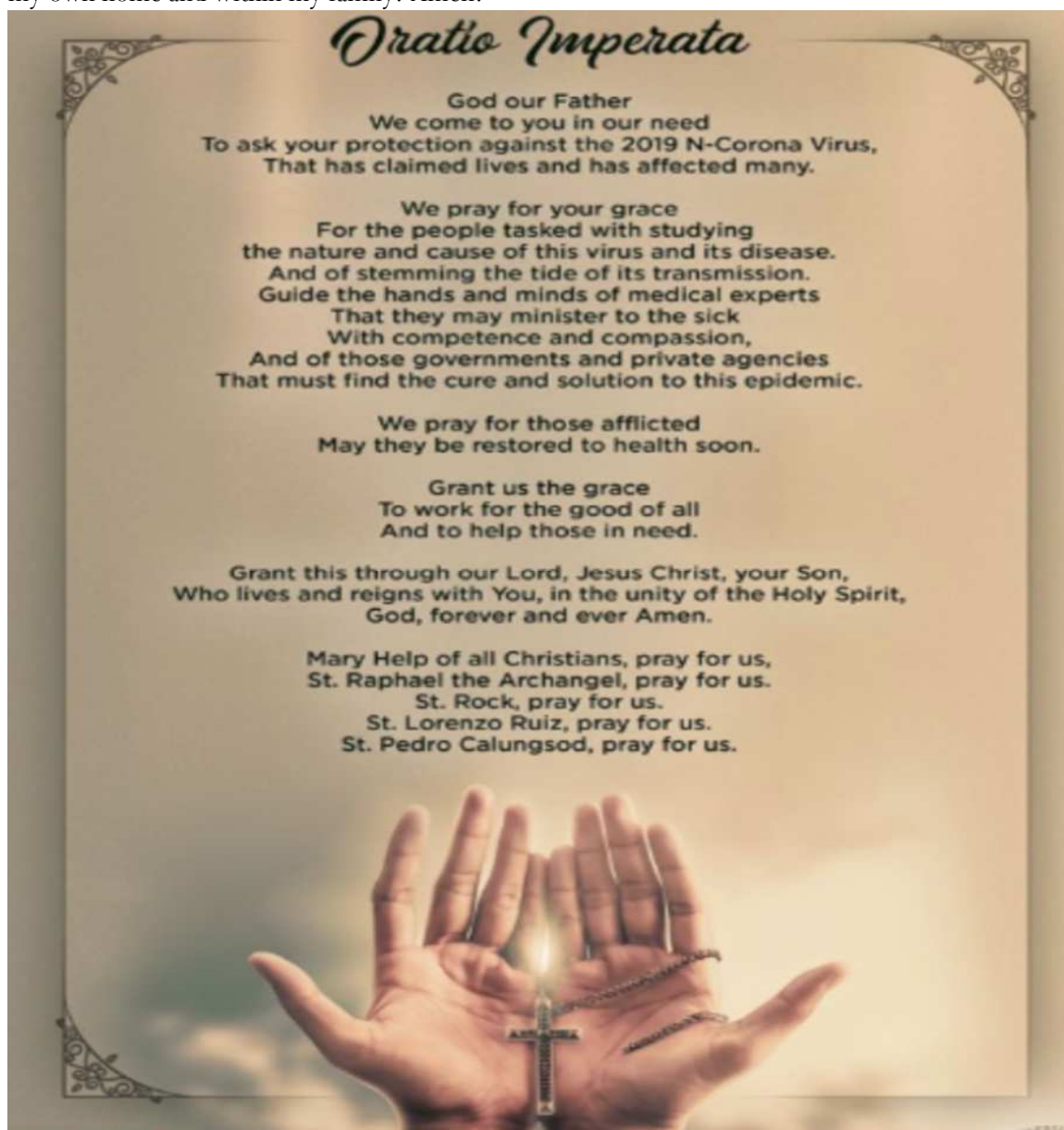



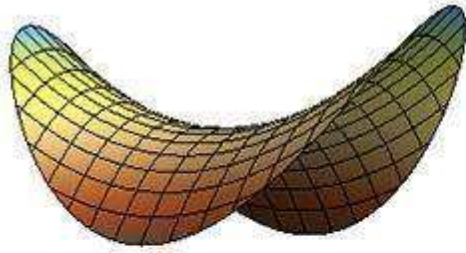
From the Grade School Moderators' Office

6. Last period teachers are requested to check on the valuables left by the students. This is to lessen the number of losses and things left after dismissal time.

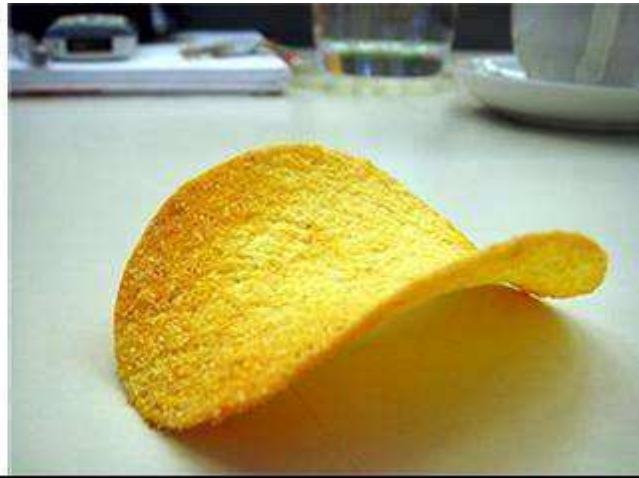

MATH TRIVIA

Did you know that the Pringles Chips are Hyperbolic Paraboloids. They were made in that shape for sturdier and easier stacking. The saddle surface makes the chips placed smoothly on top of each other. As for the chip that is placed at the bottom of the can (tube), it is able to retain its shape without breaking because the net weight of the chips does not usually exceed 150 grams.
